PROPERTY is a better and safer investment than stocks and shares in the global economic slump, according to portfolio managers from the Young Group.

Experts analysing the market said in the last 55 years UK house prices have had an annual fall in just five, whereas the FTSE 100 index has never reached the peak of December 1999 in the years since.
